

At North Goshen, we celebrate children as full participants in our worship life, and we offer several options to support them — and their grown-ups — on Sunday mornings.

Children's Church is available for ages 3 through grade 4 during the second half of the service, giving kids a space to learn, play, and explore the story of faith together.

Nursery care for infants through age 3 is offered throughout the service by our team of caring adults and youth.

Buddy Bags with quiet activities, books, and art supplies are available in the narthex for children who prefer to stay in the sanctuary.
