### Worship Focus: Stranger Who Came to See

This **Epiphany Sunday**, we'll focus on *El Día de los Reyes Magos* — the *Day of the Three Kings* — a tradition deeply meaningful to many in our Latino community.

Instead of a traditional sermon, members of our congregation will share their stories and memories of Three Kings Day through a panel discussion led by Nick King. They'll tell us how they learned the story as children, how they celebrate now, and what this tradition teaches about faith, generosity, and welcome.

The Magi in the Bible were foreigners who traveled far to meet Jesus. As we hear from those in our community who have also journeyed far from home, we'll discover how their stories connect to the ancient story of the wise ones following the star.

## Ways Children Worship With Us

At North Goshen, we celebrate children as full participants in our worship life, and we offer several options to support them — and their grown-ups — on Sunday mornings.

**Children's Church** is available for ages 3 through grade 4 during the second half of the service, giving kids a space to learn, play, and explore the story of faith together.

**Nursery care** for infants through age 3 is offered throughout the service by our team of caring adults and youth.

**Buddy Bags** with quiet activities, books, and art supplies are available in the narthex for children who prefer to stay in the sanctuary.

Wherever children choose to be — up front, in a pew, downstairs, or moving between spaces — their joy and presence are a welcome part of our worship.
