About the Cover: To mark the final Sunday in our *Sermon on the Mount* worship series, this week's cover features a **word cloud**—a form of digital word art that visually represents language in a way that helps us see both meaning and movement.

This image was created using a **word art generator**, which takes the words from Matthew chapters 5–7 and displays them in varying sizes based on how often each word appears in the text. The more frequently a word shows up in Jesus' sermon, the larger it appears in the image.

Because our church is bilingual and multicultural, the word cloud includes both **Spanish and English**—a visual reminder that Jesus' words are for all people, in every language, in every place.
