**Did You Know? Anabaptist Origins** 

Women Were Early Leaders in the Movement. Despite the risk of imprisonment and death, women like Ursula Jost and Margaretha Sattler helped shape early Anabaptist theology and community life.

In 1527, just two years after the movement began, a gathering of Anabaptists in Schleitheim drafted a confession of faith. It emphasized community, mutual aid, nonviolence, and following Jesus together—even if it meant persecution.
