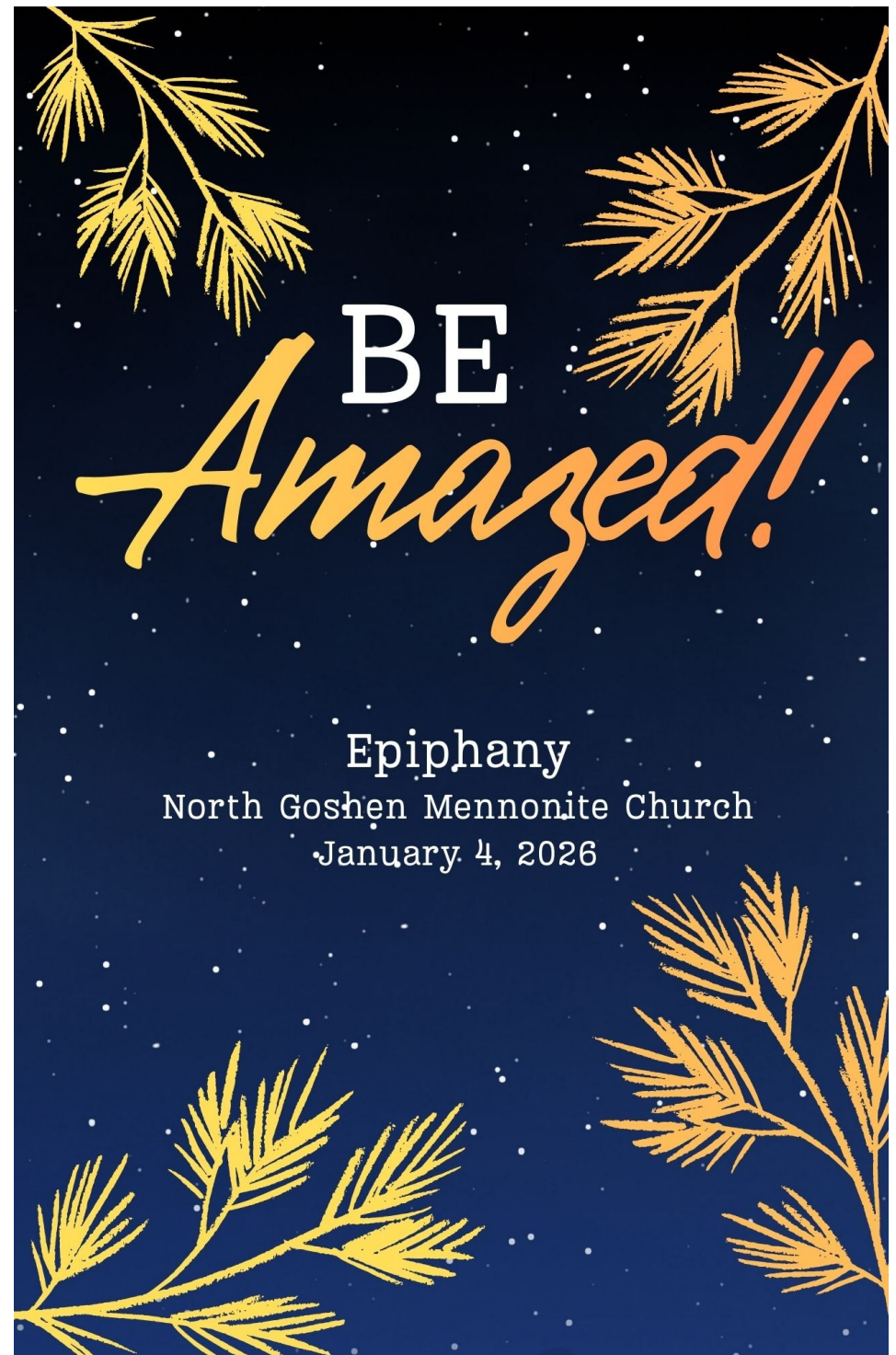

Worship Focus: Wedding at Cana

Jesus' first sign happens at a wedding - the most ordinary of celebrations. When the wine runs out, Jesus transforms 180 gallons of water into the best wine, revealing a God of outrageous abundance who cares about our joy. Next Sunday launches our six-week Epiphany series ***Signs of Life/Señales de Vida***, following Jesus through John's Gospel from abundance to healing to sight as we journey toward Lent. We'll see Jesus crossing boundaries, offering living water, and revealing God's glory through embodied encounters with real people. This is Epiphany - manifestation, light dawning - and we're invited not just to witness but to be changed.
