Next Sunday we gather at the desert's edge, where the prophet Isaiah cries out: "Everyone who thirsts, come to the waters!" (Isaiah 55:1-13). Ways Children Worship With Us

At North Goshen, we celebrate children as full participants in our worship life, and we offer several options to support them — and their grown-ups — on Sunday mornings.

Children's Church is available for ages 3 through grade 4 during the second half of the service, giving kids a space to learn, play, and explore the story of faith together.

Nursery care for infants through age 3 is offered throughout the service by our team of caring adults and youth.
